OPENN NEGOTIATION CONTRACT PREPARATION WESTERN AUSTRALIA

Set out below are instructions for correctly preparing the documentation for an Openn Negotiation, and an explanation of the Openn Negotiation Sales Process generally.

Listing and Contract Preparation

- The Seller and Agent agree and execute the Authority to Conduct the Sale of Land or Strata Title by Openn Negotiation (Western Australia). Attached should be the following:
 - A copy of the Openn Negotiation Bidding Rules and Offer Terms of Use (Western Australia), labelled as Schedule 1
 - The template Contract for the Sale of Land or Strata Title by Offer and Acceptance together with the General Conditions incorporated into that template, labelled as Annexure A
- 2. The Seller(s) and Agent sign the Authority
- 3. The Agent is now ready to commence the open home and marketing program.

Securing Qualified Bidders

- 1. First, the prospective bidder must go to www.openn.com.au or download the Openn Negotiation App, find the property, register and then place a pending bid. The pending bid can be lower than what they think the property is worth;
- 2. Next, the agent needs the bidder to complete and sign the **Openn Negotiation Bidding Rules and Offer Terms of Use (Western Australia)**
- 3. The Agent should provide and or make available all of the necessary documentation as required by legislation for an auction ie;
 - a. Contract for Sale of Land or Strata Title by Offer and Acceptance;
 - b. The General Conditions
 - c. Any other documentation
- 4. The Agent will discuss the documents with the bidder, recording any Offer Terms the Bidder may request. The Bidder may be confirmed as a Qualified Bidder and their bid accepted on the App, provided the Agent is in receipt of:
 - a. Buyers Authority to Bid and Terms of Use signed by the Bidder(s) & Seller(s);
 - b. All other documents in compliance with the Real Estate and Business Agents Act 1978 (WA) and the Auction Sales Act 1973 (WA)



Completing signing and exchanging the Contract

- 1. Pursuant to the authority provided by the Seller(s) to the Agent and Auctioneer in the Authority to Conduct the Sale of Land or Strata Title by Openn Negotiation (Western Australia) the Seller(s) appoint:
 - a. The Agent or a Sales Representative of the real estate agent employed by the Agent and the Auctioneer to sign the contract for the sale of the property on the Seller's behalf and;
 - b. The Agent to accept any deposit and aid settlement to the nominated conveyancer
- 2. Pursuant to the authority provided by the Buyer(s) in the **Openn Negotiation Bidding Rules and Offer Terms of Use (Western Australia)** the Buyer(s)
 appoint:
 - The Auctioneer to complete and sign the Contracts on behalf of the Winning Bidder, including the Offer Terms set out in Clause 7 and the Winning Bid as the Price and;
 - b. Exchange the Contract with the Seller of the Property

This Authority begins immediately upon becoming a Qualified Bidder and expires automatically and without further effect on the day that is one day after the Final Bidding Stage.
